MEDICAL EXTENSION SUMMARY

If a player earns the points required to reach the top 125 threshold, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the Major Medical category. If a player earns the points required to reach the top 150 threshold, but falls short of top 125, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the 126-150 category, subject to reshuffle. If he does not reach either of these thresholds, he will fall back into the highest category for which he is eligible, or lose status.

SIGNATURE EVENTS

Field composition

The field for the The Genesis Invitational is made up of 72 players using the following eligibility criteria:

- Top 50 in the 2024 FedExCup standings
- Aon Next 10 (Nos. 51-60 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings)
- · Top finisher from the 2024 Race to Dubai, not otherwise exempt
- Aon Swing 5 (top FedExCup points earners in the Sony Open in Hawaii, The American Express, Farmers Insurance Open and WM Phoenix Open, not otherwise exempt)
- Current-year tournament winners
- · PGA TOUR members in the top 30 in the Official World Golf Ranking
- · Four sponsor exemptions restricted to PGA TOUR members
- If necessary to fill the field to 72 players, next available player(s) from the Aon Next 10 standings

No players are exempt out of the current-year tournament winner and top 30 OWGR categories, as all winners this season and all PGA TOUR members in the top 30 are exempt through a higher category.

Filling the field

New in 2025, if necessary, the field for The Genesis Invitational and all remaining Signature Events fills to 72 players using the next available player(s) from the Aon Next 10 standings (beyond No. 60 in the 2024 FedExCup Fall standings). Four players got into the field as a result: Lucas Glover, Justin Rose, Mark Hubbard and Jake Knapp. For reference, the field in 2024 was 70 players.

Last man in the field

The last man in the field is Jake Knapp, No. 64 in the FedExCup Fall standings. Knapp got into the field on Monday when tournament host Tiger Woods withdrew.

Players in the field who are exempt for the remaining Signature Events

49 of the 72 players in the field are exempt for all five remaining Signature Events

- 47 of the top 50 from the 2024 FedExCup standings are in the field (Xander Schauffele, Chris Kirk and Alex Noren are not playing this week)
- Nick Taylor (won Sony Open in Hawaii) and Harris English (won Farmers Insurance Open); all other winners this season were top 50 in 2024 (Hideki Matsuyama, Sepp Straka, Rory McIlroy, Thomas Detry)

Players in the field making their first start in a Signature Event this season

Two PGA TOUR members are making their first start in a Signature Event this season: Daniel Berger and Michael Kim, who moved into the Aon Swing 5 after finishing T2 at the WM Phoenix Open. Neither player competed in a Signature Event in 2024.

Charlie Sifford Memorial Exemption recipient Danny List is making his PGA TOUR debut.

Player-hosted Signature Event

As one of three player-hosted Signature Events, The Genesis Invitational features two modifications:

- 36-hole cut to the low 50 players (and ties) and any additional players within 10 strokes of the 36-hole lead
- · Three-year PGA TOUR exemption available to the winner

These two modifications are also in effect at the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard and the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday.
