



2025 Genesis Invitational (7th of 36 FedExCup Regular Season events)

San Diego, California February 13-16, 2025 FedExCup points: 700 (winner)

Second-Round Notes – Friday, February 14, 2025

Weather: 1.05 inches of rain in prior 24 hours. Partly cloudy. High of 60. Wind WNW 8-14 mph, gusting to 22 mph. Preferred lies were in use for round two.

Cut: 54 professionals at 4-over 148 from a field of 72 professionals (low 50 and ties and any additional players within 10 strokes of the 36-hole lead/8-under)

• Two highest cuts this season have both come at Torrey Pines Golf Course (1-over 145/Farmers Insurance Open)

Davis Thompson (1st/-8)

- Holds the 36-hole lead/co-lead in an individual stroke play event on TOUR for the second time (2023 American Express/2nd); shared 36-hole lead at 2024 Zurich Classic of New Orleans with teammate Andrew Novak en route to T23 finish
- 2024 John Deere Classic winner also owns three runner-up results in 75 starts on the PGA TOUR
- Makes second appearance at The Genesis Invitational (MC/2023)
- Best finish in five prior starts this season: T36 (The Sentry, WM Phoenix Open)
- Cards his best score in six career rounds played on the South Course at Torrey Pines (previous best: 70/R1/2025 Genesis Invitational)
- Leads the field in total birdies (12), including eight in round two; next best, nine: Tony Finau, Max Greyserman, Rory McIlroy

Miscellaneous Notes

- The three player-hosted Signature Events (The Genesis Invitational, Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday) are the only Signature Events that feature a 36-hole cut (the low 50 and ties and any additional players within 10 strokes of the 36-hole lead)
- After no bogey-free rounds on Thursday, Scottie Scheffler (2nd/-7) posts the only bogey-free score in the second round; marks his second bogey-free round at Torrey Pines (South): R3/70/2022 Farmers Insurance Open (T20); finished T7 in the 2021 U.S. Open at Torrey Pines
- First-round leader **Denny McCarthy** (3rd/-6) is one of two players with multiple eagles through 36 holes (R1/No. 18, R2/No. 6); other, **Stephan Jaeger** (R1/No. 1, R2/No. 6)
- World No. 3 Rory McIroy (4th/-5) won the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am in his season debut, capturing his 27th PGA TOUR title; victory this week would mark the first time in his career to open a PGA TOUR season with consecutive wins; finished T7 in the 2021 U.S. Open at Torrey Pines
- Ludvig Åberg (T5/-4) held a share of the 36-hole lead (with Lanto Griffin at 6-under 138) three weeks ago in the Farmers Insurance Open at Torrey Pines, eventually finishing T42 while playing with an illness on the weekend
- In nine career appearances at The Genesis Invitational, Patrick Rodgers (T5/-4) has three top-25 finishes (best: T12/2021)
- Nick Dunlap (7th/-3) seeks his third PGA TOUR title; in 2024, became the first player in PGA TOUR history to win as an amateur and as a professional in the same season (2024 American Express, 2024 Barracuda Championship)
- Michael Kim (T14/-1), who attended Torrey Pines High School, earned a spot in field via the Aon Swing 5 after a T2 finish at last week's WM Phoenix Open; marks his first start in a Signature Event in the last two seasons

- Defending champion **Hideki Matsuyama** (T34/+2) follows an opening-round 74 with a second-round 72
- Matthieu Pavon (T48/+4), winner of the 2024 Farmers Insurance Open, was 5-over through five holes to start The Genesis Invitational; follows first-round 79 with 3-under 69 to make the cut on the number
- Danny List, recipient of the Charlie Sifford Memorial Exemption, misses the cut in his PGA TOUR debut
- Scoring average in round two was 71.79 compared to 74.28 in the first round
