Today – Rainfall Last 24 Hours: 0.30”. A wet and dreary day is expected at Torrey Pines with periods of drizzle and occasional showers. The greatest threat for rain will be before 9am and after 3pm, otherwise it will be cloudy with temperatures in the upper 50s. Southerly winds will continue to increase as the day progresses with gusts over 25 mph possible by the mid to late afternoon. Extended forecast – A cold front will move across southern California tonight bringing a period of rain. This rain could be heavy at times, especially between 9pm-3am. Strong winds will also develop ahead of the front with gusts over 30 mph possible. The front should clear Torrey Pines before sunrise Friday, although some remnant showers could persist through Friday morning. Completely dry conditions should eventually return Friday afternoon and then persist through the upcoming weekend. The only concern for Saturday/Sunday will be the potential for marine clouds during the morning hours.
