Weather: Mostly sunny. High of 78. Wind SSE 5-10 mph.

36-hole cut: 73 professionals at 7-under 135 from a field of 155 professionals and one amateur. Marks the lowest 36-hole cut in tournament history (previous low: 5-under 138/2017) and lowest on TOUR since the 2024 ISCO Championship (8-under 136).

Andrew Novak (1st/-16) – SS-PL

- Followed up an opening round 9-under 61 on the Seaside Course with a 7-under 65 on the Plantation Course to take the 36-hole solo lead
- At 16-under 126 records the lowest opening 36-hole score of his career on TOUR in an individual stroke play event (130/2024 WM Phoenix Open/finished T8)
- Breaks the 36-hole scoring record at The RSM Classic (128, six occurrences entering the week, most recently by Robert Streb in 2020)
- Second career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; first in an individual stroke play event
 - Held the 36-hole lead with teammate Davis Thompson at 2024 Zurich Classic of New Orleans (finished T23)
- Making his 113th career start on the PGA TOUR and sixth appearance at The RSM Classic (best finish: T26/2021)
- Fourth-year PGA TOUR member, in the midst of his best season on TOUR, highlighted by a win at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (with teammate Ben Griffin) and a No. 25 finish in the FedExCup
- Third highest ranked player in the field at No. 33 in the Official World Golf Ranking

Additional Player Notes

- Patrick Rodgers** (T2/-15/PL) holds his best 36-hole position at The RSM Classic in his 10th appearance (previous best: T9/2024/finished T17)
- Making his 45th PGA TOUR start, **Michael Thorbjornsen** (T2/-15/SS) logs a 36-hole career-low at 15-under 127 (previous low: 131/2024 John Deere Classic/finished T2)
- Making tournament debut, **Sami Valimaki** (T4/-14/SS) matches his career-low 36-hole score at 14-under 128 (2025 World Wide Technology Championship/finished T2)
- Greyson Sigg** (T4/-14/PL) posts a back nine 8-under 28 en route to an 18-hole career-low 8-under 62 (previous best: 63/R3/2024 The American Express); 8-under on Nos. 12-18, marking the best birdie-eagle streak on Tour since 2016 (Jhonattan Vegas/8-under/2016 ISCO Championship/R2)
- Sponsor exemption **Johnny Keefer** (6th/-13/PL), who finished No. 1 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, cards an 18-hole career-low 8-under 64 in his sixth career PGA TOUR start (previous best: 65/R1/The RSM Classic/SS)
- 18-hole co-leader **Doug Ghim** (T13/-11/PL) follows up an opening round 10-under 60 at the Seaside course with a 1-under 71 at the Plantation course; holds his best 36-hole position at The RSM Classic in his sixth appearance (previous best: T39/2021/finished T40)
- Team RSM member **Chris Kirk** (T46/-8/SS) carded a 6-under 64 on the Seaside course to make the 36-hole cut

FedExCup Fall Notes

- The 2025 RSM Classic is the final event of the FedExCup Fall, a group of seven tournaments played after the TOUR Championship that finalizes eligibility for the 2026 PGA TOUR Season; the top 100 players in the FedExCup Fall standings at the conclusion of The RSM Classic will earn exempt status on TOUR for the 2026 season
 - No players are currently projected to move inside the top 100
- The Aon Next 10 is an eligibility pathway that awards access into Signature Events, recognizing the top 10 players, not otherwise exempt, from the FedExCup standings; Nos. 51-60 in the final FedExCup Fall standings at the conclusion of The RSM Classic will serve as the Aon Next 10 for the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational
 - Players currently projected to move into Nos. 51-60:
 - **Patrick Rodgers** (T2/No. 63 to No. 52), **Michael Thorbjornsen** (T2/No. 72 to No. 54), **Nico Echavarria** (T13/No. 62 to No. 60)
