



Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory



Maverick McNealy The RSM Classic

Maverick McNealy earned his first career PGA TOUR win at the 2024 RSM Classic and the 10th player to earn their first TOUR title at this event (most of any TOUR event since 2012). McNealy is the 15th First-Time winner on TOUR Last season.

2nd McNealy ranked Second in the field in Proximity to the Hole for the week, averaging 29' 1", averaging 10' 6" closer than the field average on the Seaside Course

79.2% McNealy hit 79.2% of his greens in regulation en route to victory (57/72), his fourth event on TOUR hitting at least 57 greens for the week

Made 20 birdies or better (19 birdies/1 eagle) en route to victory, his most birdies or better in four career RSM Classic appearances

-6 played the par 3s a combined six under on the Seaside course en route to victory, tied with Tyler Duncan (2019) for the best Par 3 Performance on Seaside by an RSM Classic winner.

FedExCup Fall Storylines

The 2025 The RSM Classic is the seventh and final event of the FedExCup Fall, a group of seven tournaments played after the TOUR Championship that finalizes eligibility for the 2026 PGA TOUR Season.

The top 50 players in the FedExCup standings through the TOUR Championship are locked in their positions while No. 51 and beyond carry their FedExCup points over.

Aon Next 10 (players 51-60) through the FedExCup Fall will qualify for two Signature Events in 2025: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational.

Winners of events during the FedExCup Fall receive a two-year PGA TOUR exemption, OWGR points and spots in THE PLAYERS Championship, RBC Heritage and PGA Championship in 2026

What's at Stake in the FedExCup Fall:

- Aon Next 10: Players in the Aon Next 10 through the RSM Classic will be eligible for the two west coast Signature Events (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am and The Genesis Invitational)
- The Top 100: Will be fully-exempt for the 2026 PGA TOUR season
- 101-150: Earn conditional status on PGA TOUR next season
- In each of the last two season 10 of the 20 players to finish inside in Aon Next 10 qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs the following season
- In each of the last two seasons, five of the 20 players to finish inside in Aon Next 10 finished inside the top 50 of the FedExCup Standings the following season and five of players qualified for the TOUR Championship the following season
- 75% With four weeks left in the FedExCup Fall season, historically 75% of the players in the Aon Next 10 at this point finish the fall season in the final Aon Next 10, increasing by 15% from three weeks prior when the percentage was 60%.

Broadcast Window Notes Brian Harman (13th), Andrew Novak (25th), Michael Brennan (98th)

- Brian Harman is -94 under at The RSM Classic ties the fourth lowest score to par at All-Time (min 8 rds played). Harman has his highest (87.50%) and second (85.71%) highest driving accuracy PCT at this event (2018 & 2024) in his PGA TOUR Career. Since his win at the 2023 The Open Championship, Harman has made 5 top 5s and has 1 win at the 2025 Valero Texas Open.
- Andrew Novak has improved each of the last two consecutive seasons SG: Around-the-Green on the PGA TOUR. Novak has improved in these four putting statistics from Last Season to This Season (SG, One-Putt PCT, Putts Per Round, Putting from 15-20). 2021 The RSM Classic was his second lowest Par 4 Scoring Average at an event in his PGA TOUR Career.
- **87.50** Michael Brennan leads in Driving Accuracy Percentage in FedExCup Fall This Season (min 8 rds played). Brennan has the highest SG: Tee-to-Green AVG (+2.70) in the FedExCup Fall This Season (min 8 rds played)

- -57 Harris English has is -57 under on Par 5's at The RSM Classic in his career, the second most under par on Par 5's of any player at The RSM Classic. English has also hit 75.66% of greens at The RSM Classic, his third highest Greens in Regulation PCT at an event in his PGA TOUR career. This season English has 12 Top 25 finishes, tied for second most in a season in his PGA TOUR career.
- **87.50** Daniel Berger improved 130 positions from Last Season (T159) to This Season (29th) in Putting from 20-25', the fifth best improvement of any player. 87.50% of Bergers rounds at The RSM Classic have been in the 60's tied for second highest of any event in his PGA TOUR career. Berger also has a Birdie Average of 4.75 at The RSM Classic the 5th best of any player all time at this event.
- 556 Steven Fisk earned 556 FedExCup Fall Points, the second most points earned in the Fall. Fisk ranks inside the Top 30 in both Par 4 (T28) & Par 5 (T24) Performance this season.

- 44th Davis Thompson has improved in Driving Accuracy in each of the last two consecutive seasons on the PGA TOUR. His second highest Driving Accuracy PCT in an event was 80.36% at the 2024 RSM Classic.

Stephan Jaeger (66th), Adam Schenk (67th), Nico Echavarria (62nd)

- Stephan Jaeger improved 127 positions in Sand Save Percentage from Last Season (161st) to This Season (34th), the third biggest improvement of any player on the PGA TOUR. Jaeger this season has performed better in Rd 1 then in Rd 2, 61.54% of his opening round are under par compared to Rd 2 (48.00%).
- Adam Schenk has made 5 cuts during the FedExCup Fall Season, tied for second most of any player without a missed cut. Schenk had his first career PGA TOUR win at the 2025 Butterfield Bermuda Championship in his 243rd career start, the 5th Most Starts Before First Win of any player since 2003.
- Nico Echavarria ranks 1st in Putting from 20-25' on the PGA TOUR This Season, he is the only player to rank inside the top 15 in these four putting statistics (Strokes Gained: Putting, One Putt PCT, Putting Inside 10', Putting from 20-25'). Echavarria is the most under par on Par 3's in the FedExCup Fall This Season.
