Hideki Matsuyama (1st/-27)

- At 27-under, equals lowest 54-hole score in relation to par on the PGA TOUR (on record); joins Nick Dunlap (2024 American Express) and Patrick Reed (2014 American Express)
- Marks lowest 54-hole score to par at The Sentry since the event moved to Kapalua in 1999
- 192 marks career-low 54-hole score, previously posted 193 en route to victory at 2024 FedEx St. Jude Championship
- Holds 54-hole lead/co-lead for the eighth time on TOUR (4-for-7 to date; 2016 WGC-HSBC Champions, 2021 Masters Tournament, 2021 Baycurrent Championship, 2024 FedEx St. Jude Championship)
- Posts career-high 11 birdies, previously 10 birdies on two occasions, most recently during round four of the 2019 BMW Championship
- In search of his 11th PGA TOUR victory in his 265th start (2014 Memorial Tournament presented by Workday, 2016 WM Phoenix Open, 2016 WGC-HSBC Champions, 2017 WM Phoenix Open, 2017 WGC-Bridgestone Invitational, 2021 Masters Tournament, 2021 Baycurrent Championship, 2022 Sony Open in Hawaii, 2024 Genesis Invitational, 2024 FedEx St. Jude Championship)

Collin Morikawa (2nd/-26)

- 193 marks career-low 54-hole score, previously had 195 on two occasions, first at The Sentry in 2023 and later at the 2024 Travelers Championship
- Hit 52 of 54 greens in regulation through three rounds of The Sentry; for comparison the PGA TOUR record is 53 set by Mike Heinen (1995 Walt Disney World Golf Classic) and Brad Faxon (1991 Farmers Insurance Open)
- Marks ninth round of 65 or better at The Sentry since 2020, most of any player
- Holds five top-seven finishes in as many appearances at The Sentry (T7/2020; T7/2021; T5/2022; 2/2023; T5/2024)
- Seeks seventh career TOUR title and first since 2023 Baycurrent Championship

Miscellaneous Notes

- In his tournament debut, **Thomas Detry** (3rd) posts career-low 54-hole score (197), his previous best was 199 at the 2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship; seeks first PGA TOUR title in his 64th career start
- **Sungjae Im** (4th) collected nine birdies and one eagle to post an 11-under 62, which ties his career-low round on TOUR (three times previously, most recent: R3/2024 Baycurrent Championship); also marks his lowest score in 19 rounds at The Plantation Course at Kapalua; in search of his third career TOUR title (2020 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, 2021 Shriners Children’s Open)
