Tommy Fleetwood (T1/-13)

- Cards 63, his lowest score in 17 previous rounds at the TOUR Championship (previous: 64/R1/2025)
- Seventh 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (most recent: 2025 FedEx St. Jude Championship/T3); 0-for-6 converting to victory
- 36-hole total of 127 (64-63) ties his career-low on TOUR (2025 FedEx St. Jude Championship/finished T3)
- Ranks second in the field in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (2.829) and Strokes Gained: Putting (3.908) through two rounds
- Seeking his maiden PGA TOUR victory in his 164th career start; entered the week ranked No. 5 in the FedExCup standings, the highest-ranked player in the FedExCup without a win this season
- Fifth career TOUR Championship appearance (T11/2018, T16/2019, T6/2023, 20th/2024)
- One of two players (Scottie Scheffler) to finish inside the top 10 in each of the first two Playoffs events (T3/FedEx St. Jude Championship, T4/BMW Championship)
- Seven top-10s this season are his second-highest total on TOUR since 2017-18 (9/2023)

Russell Henley (T1/-13)

- 11th 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (most recent: 2024 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard/T4); 2-for-10 converting to victory (2013 Sony Open in Hawaii, 2023 World Wide Technology Championship)
- Enters the week having finished T17 or better in each of his last six starts on TOUR (best: T2/Travelers Championship)
- Seeking his sixth career PGA TOUR victory (2013 Sony Open in Hawaii, 2014 Cognizant Classic, 2017 Texas Children's Houston Open, 2023 World Wide Technology Championship, 2025 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard)
- Fifth career TOUR Championship appearance (12th/2014, T3/2017, T14/2023, T4/2024)
- Nine top-10s in 17 starts this season, including a victory at the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (4.824) through two rounds

Miscellaneous notes:

- **Cameron Young** (3rd/-11) posts 62, tying his low 18-hole score on TOUR this season (R2/Wyndham Championship); seeking second career PGA TOUR title (2025 Wyndham Championship)
- BMW Championship runner-up **Robert MacIntyre** (T4/-10) posts bogey-free 66; is making his second career TOUR Championship appearance
- 2021 FedExCup Champion **Patrick Cantlay** (T4/-10) posts 36-hole total of 130, his lowest on TOUR this season (previous: 132/The American Express/T5); played his final three holes in 4-under, including an eagle on the par-5 18th
- Reigning FedExCup Champion **Scottie Scheffler's** (6th/-8) second-round 69 marks his 19th consecutive round under par (last round over par: R3/2025 Travelers Championship/72/+2); with a win, would become the first player to win back-to-back FedExCup titles

- **Shane Lowry** (T7/-7) holed a birdie putt on the 14th hole from 97' 6", the longest in FedExCup Playoffs history and sixth longest on TOUR in ShotLink era (since 2003) enroute to a bogey-free 63
- Four of the six FedExCup Champions in the field are T10 or better after round two (T4/Patrick Cantlay/2021, 6th/Scottie Scheffler/2024, T7/Rory McIlroy/2016, 2019, 2022, T7/Justin Thomas/2017)
