Tommy Fleetwood (Winner/-18)

- 2025 FedExCup Champion posts final-round 68 to win his first career PGA TOUR title in his 164th start at the age of 34 years, 7 months, 5 days
- Earns a five-year PGA TOUR exemption (thru 2030)
- Entered the week ranked No. 5 in the FedExCup standings, the highest-ranked player in the FedExCup without a win this season
- First player since Chad Campbell (2003) to make the TOUR Championship his first career PGA TOUR victory
- 18th different PGA TOUR winner from England; second FedExCup Champion from England (Justin Rose/2018)
- Wins the TOUR Championship in his fifth career appearance (previous best finish: T6/2023)
- Becomes the 13th first-time winner on TOUR during the 2025 season
- First player to finish inside the top six of the leaderboard after every round of the FedExCup Playoffs
- Posted all 12 rounds of the FedExCup Playoffs in the 60s, including four rounds of 64 or better
- Had 30 top-five finishes on TOUR before collecting his first career title, including six this season
- Led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (8.148), more than doubling the next-highest total (Sam Burns/3.901)
- Holed 12 putts from 10 feet or longer, tied for the most in the field (Ben Griffin)
- 27 birdies marks his career-high tournament total (previous: 26/2022 CJ CUP in South Carolina)
- Projected to move to a career-high No. 6 in the Official World Golf Ranking

Miscellaneous notes:

- 2021 FedExCup Champion **Patrick Cantlay** (T2/-15) posts 71 in search of his second career FedExCup title; led the field in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (6.068) and Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (5.164)
- Russell Henley (T2/-15) cards 69 to post all four rounds in the 60s for the first time in five career appearances at the TOUR Championship; marks his second consecutive top-five finish at the TOUR Championship
- Reigning FedExCup Champion **Scottie Scheffler** (T4/-14) posts 68 for his 21st consecutive round in the 60s, tying the record set by Patrick Cantlay; Scheffler was seeking to become the first player to win back-to-back FedExCup titles
- Corey Conners (T4/-14) posts 62 for his low 18-hole score on the season by four strokes and his low 18-hole score in 20 career rounds at East Lake Golf Club
