There is a slight chance of storms as early as 3pm but are more likely to occur after 5pm. Heavy downpours and gusty outflow winds are possible this afternoon.

Extended forecast – A frontal boundary will stall near Atlanta on Friday and Saturday. Temperatures will be cooler the next few days, although humidity levels will remain high. Chances for thunderstorms continue into Sunday with drier air entering the state on Monday.
