Austin Eckroat (T1/-8)

- Records a bogey-free 8-under 62, his career-low round (previous: 63/most recently at 2024 World Wide Technology Championship/R4)
- Holds second career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR (2023 RSM Classic/finished T8)
- Making his fourth start at the Travelers Championship (T47/2021, T24/2023, T27/2024)
- Made his PGA TOUR debut at the 2021 Travelers Championship on a sponsor exemption
- Best finish in 17 starts this season: T13/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am
- Two-time PGA TOUR winner: 2024 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, 2024 World Wide Technology Championship

Scottie Scheffler (T1/-8)

- World No. 1 cards his second-lowest opening-round score of the season (61/THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson)
- Sixth career 18-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR and second this season (THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson/Won); 2-for-5 to date
- Reigning FedExCup Champion leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (4.194)
- Owns two top-10 finishes in five career starts in the Travelers Championship (T4/2023, Won/2024)
- Seeks to become the first player since Phil Mickelson (2001-2002) to win consecutive Travelers Championship titles
- One of two players to win the Travelers Championship and the FedExCup in the same season (Dustin Johnson/2020)
- 16-time PGA TOUR winner in search of fourth victory of the season (THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson, PGA Championship, the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday)
- Ranks T54 on the all-time wins list, tied with five others (Jack Burke, Jr., Ralph Guldahl, Mark O'Meara, Justin Thomas, Tom Weiskopf)

Additional notes:

- The Travelers Championship is the last of eight Signature Events during the 2025 PGA TOUR Season
- Wyndham Clark (T3/-6) opens with a 64, his second-best score in 23 rounds at TPC River Highlands (63/R4/2023) and leads the field in Strokes Gained: Off the Tee (1.761); making eighth appearance at the event (best: T9/2024)
- World No. 2 Rory McIlroy (T3/-6) opens with a 64, his seventh round of 64 or better in 21 rounds at TPC River Highlands (best: 62/R1/2022); has finished in the top-20 in five previous starts at the Travelers Championship (best: T7/2023)
- Making his 15th career appearance at the Travelers Championship, 2023 winner **Keegan Bradley** (T3/-6) has three top-10s at the event (T8/2017, T2/2019, Won/2023)
- Last week's winner of the U.S. Open, J.J. Spaun (T63/+3) cards a 73 in his seventh Travelers Championship start; last to win a major and win on TOUR the following week: Scottie Scheffler (2024 Masters Tournament, 2024 RBC Heritage)
- Brian Campbell (sickness) withdrew prior to the start of the opening round and was replaced by **Davis Riley**, who shot 4-under 66 and sits T7
- 2017 Travelers Championship winner Jordan Spieth withdrew during the first round with a neck and upper back injury
