Tommy Fleetwood (1st/-16)

- Seeks first PGA TOUR victory in 159th start; seven-time DP World Tour winner has 41 top-10 finishes, the most of any player without a win on TOUR since 1983
- Owns five runner-up finishes on TOUR (most recent: 2023 RBC Canadian Open where he lost a playoff to Nick Taylor)
- Would become ninth first-time winner on TOUR this season and first since Ryan Fox (ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic)
- Would become 18th player to earn his first TOUR title at the Travelers Championship and first since 2013 (Ken Duke)
- Would be the first international winner of the Travelers Championship since 2016 (Russell Knox)
- Cards bogey-free 63, including five birdies and one eagle on No. 13; marks fifth time he has eagled the par-5 13th at TPC River Highlands, the most of any hole in his TOUR career
- 194 marks his lowest 54-hole total on TOUR (previous: 195/2018 BMW Championship/finish: T8)
- Second time holding the 54-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR; 0-for-1 to date (2020 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches/3rd)
- Makes fifth appearance at Travelers Championship (T13/2019, T46/2022, MC/2023, 15th/2024); 16 of 17 rounds of paror-better at TPC River Highlands (71/R4/2022)
- Three of his four top-10s this season have come in Signature Events (T5/The Genesis Invitational, 7th/RBC Heritage, T4/Truist Championship); other: T4/Charles Schwab Challenge

Additional notes:

- Russell Henley (T2/-13) cards bogey-free 61 to tie career-low round on TOUR (2019 John Deere/R4); seeks second victory of the season and also second Signature Event victory (Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard) and sixth career win on TOUR; would become sixth multiple winner on TOUR this season (Rory McIlroy/3, Scottie Scheffler/3, Ryan Fox/2, Ben Griffin/2, Sepp Straka/2); best result in seven appearances at Travelers Championship is T6/2018
- 2023 Travelers Championship winner **Keegan Bradley** (T2/-13) cards seven birdies en route to a bogey-free 63; seeks eighth career title on TOUR and first since 2024 BMW Championship; would become eighth multiple-time winner of the event (first since Bubba Watson in 2018)
- Australian Jason Day (4th/-11) seeks 14th career TOUR win and first since 2023 THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson; best result in 10 appearances at Travelers Championship is T8/2019; best finish in 11 starts this season: T3/American Express
- World No. 1 and 2024 Travelers Championship winner **Scottie Scheffler** (T8/-7) opens the third round with a triplebogey 7, which marks 300 days since his last triple bogey on TOUR (No. 10/R4/2024 BMW Championship); owns two top-10 finishes in five career starts in the Travelers Championship (T4/2023, Won/2024)
