MEDICAL EXTENSION SUMMARY

If a player earns the points required to reach the top 125 threshold, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the Major Medical category. If a player earns the points required to reach the top 150 threshold, but falls short of top 125, he is eligible to play the remainder of the season out of the 126-150 category, subject to reshuffle. If he does not reach either of these thresholds, he will fall back into the highest category for which he is eligible, or lose status.

Medical extension storylines – ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic

2018 PGA TOUR Rookie of the Year Aaron Wise is making his first of 26 starts available on a Major Medical Extension after being limited to one start in 2024 (MC/Puerto Rico Open). Wise earned a two-year exemption by qualifying for the 2022 TOUR Championship and is looking to match No. 125 in the 2024 FedExCup standings (419.861 points).

Scott Gutschewski is making the final start on his Minor Medical Extension and needs to win to retain status on the PGA TOUR. He is fully exempt on the Korn Ferry Tour this season out of the Tournament Winner category.

AON SWING 5

The ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic is the first event counting towards the Aon Swing 5 for the Memorial Tournament and Travelers Championship. The Aon Swing 5 for the Memorial Tournament uses points earned at the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic and the Charles Schwab Challenge, while the Travelers Championship also includes FedExCup points earned at the RBC Canadian Open.

Although winners of additional events are not guaranteed spots in Signature Events, the winner of each additional event this season has qualified for the next Signature Event through the Aon Swing 5.

TOP 50 RETENTION TRACKING

28 of the top 50 players in the 2024 FedExCup standings are in the top 50 of the current season's standings through the THE CJ CUP Byron Nelson. At No. 6, Andrew Novak is the highest in the FedExCup standings among players that were outside the top 50 in 2024 (No. 68 in 2024).

For reference:

- » Through the 2024 CJ CUP Byron Nelson, 31 of the top 50 players in the 2023 FedExCup standings were in the top 50 of the FedExCup standings.
- » 31 of the top 50 players in the 2023 FedExCup standings finished the 2024 season in the top 50 of the FedExCup standings.

PGA CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATION

The field for next week's PGA Championship is set, with two places held for the winners of the Truist Championship and ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic, if not otherwise exempt.

Truist Championship

71 of the 72 players in the field at the Truist Championship are exempt for the PGA Championship. The only one not exempt is Michael Thorbjornsen (third alternate for the PGA Championship).

ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic

21 players in the field at the ONEflight Myrtle Beach Classic are exempt for the PGA Championship. If one of the other 111 players in the field wins, he will earn an exemption in the PGA Championship. The 21 players that are exempt are:
