Sepp Straka (Won/-16)

- Fourth career PGA TOUR victory in his 180th start at the age of 32 years, 10 days
- Collects 700 FedExCup points and moves from No. 4 to No. 2 in the FedExCup
- **PGA TOUR wins (4):** 2022 Cognizant Classic in The Palm Beaches, 2023 John Deere Classic, 2025 American Express, 2025 Truist Championship
- Second multiple winner during the 2025 PGA TOUR Season (Rory McIlroy: AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, THE PLAYERS Championship, Masters Tournament)
- Successfully converts his second of three 54-hole leads/co-leads this season (other: 2025 American Express)
- Marks his fifth finish of T15 or better in the first six Signature Events this season (T15/The Sentry, T7/AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, T5/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, T13/RBC Heritage, Won/Truist Championship)
- Finished second in Strokes Gained: Putting (8.660) after entering the week ranked 63rd this season
- Projected to move inside the top 10 in the Official World Golf Ranking for the first time in his career

Additional Player Notes

- **Shane Lowry** (T2/-14) bogeys two of his final three holes (Nos. 16 and 18) for an even-par 70 in search of his first individual title on TOUR since the 2019 Open Championship; fourth top-10 finish and second runner-up in 11 starts this season (AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am); led the field in Strokes Gained: Approach the Green (6.720) after entering the week ranked 11th this season
- **Justin Thomas** (T2/-14) collects his 10th career runner-up finish on TOUR and third of 2025 (The American Express, Valspar Championship), the most of any player on TOUR this season
- **Patrick Cantlay** (T4/-12) posts 65 for his third top-five finish in 10 starts this season (T5/The American Express, T5/The Genesis Invitational)
- Second-year PGA TOUR member **Jacob Bridgeman** (T4/-12) led the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (9.671), holing 531 feet, 4 inches worth of putts, the ninth-most all time in the ShotLink era (since 2003); claims his third top-five finish of the season after qualifying for the Truist Championship by virtue of his position below the top 10 in the Aon Next 10 standings in order to fill the field to 72 players
- In his 154th start on TOUR, **Tommy Fleetwood** (T4/-12) collects his 26th career top-five finish, the second-most of any player without a victory (Bobby Wadkins/29)
