**Today** – Overcast skies are in place this morning with the potential for drizzle or rain showers, mainly between 8-11am. Once this threat ends, clearing skies are expected into the afternoon with temperatures reaching the upper 80s. A cold front will try to push through TPC San Antonio late today, most likely after 4-5pm. A wind shift would occur and there is a low (20-30%) chance for shower/T-storm development along it. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.05" w/ higher amounts possible in T-storms.

**Extended forecast** – A higher threat for showers/T-storms likely develops late tonight with this activity impacting the area between 4-10am. Enough moisture/instability could linger over the area Saturday afternoon/evening that a low chance (15%) for precipitation is warranted. Otherwise, the stronger push of drier/stable air arrives Saturday night. Northerly winds are expected Saturday/Sunday with gusts upwards of 25 mph (strongest winds favor Sunday).
