Today – Overcast skies and any areas of drizzle will give way to sunshine this afternoon. Given nearby front boundaries, a very low (5-10%) chance for an isolated shower/T-storm will be included in the forecast after 4pm. Predominately south/southeast winds can be expected throughout the day although they may become erratic for a time between 10am-2pm.

Extended forecast – Areas of drizzle or light showers should develop across the area tonight and could persist through much of the day Friday. If any lightning occurs it would be Friday afternoon. A higher threat for showers/T-storms likely develops Friday night with this activity pushing out of the area between 4-10am on Saturday. Cooler and drier air will spread across the area Saturday afternoon into Sunday. This will bring brisk northerly winds to the area with gusts of 20-25 mph possible both days.
