



# **Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory**

Since 1983 (22 Years, 2 Months, 7 Days)

Akshay Bhatia earned 500 FedExCup points and his second PGA TOUR Career victory at the 2024 Valero Texas Open. Bhatia made a 5' 9" birdie on the first playoff hole.


