

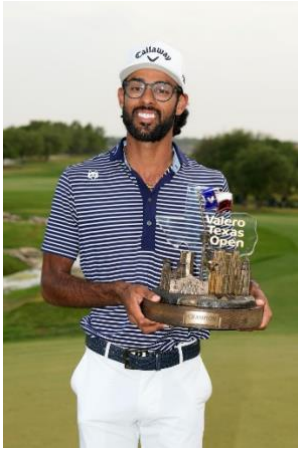

Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Akshay Bhatia earned 500 FedExCup points and his second PGA TOUR Career victory at the 2024 Valero Texas Open. Bhatia made a 5' 9" birdie on the first playoff hole.

The next Signature Event in the 2025 PGA TOUR Season is the RBC Heritage, played the week after the Masters Tournament. The Aon Next 10 is filled with the top 10 players in the FedExCup standings through the Masters that did not finish in the top 50 of the 2024 FedExCup Playoffs and Eligibility Points List, while the Aon Swing 5 is made up of the next five players earning the most points in the Puerto Rico Open, Valspar Championship, Texas Children's Houston Open and Valero Texas Open.
