

Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Peter Malnati earned 500 FedExCup points and his second win on the PGA TOUR at the 2024 Valspar Championship. Malnati moved from 77th to 16th in the FedExCup Standings, marking his first week inside the Top 30 of the FedExCup since the start of the 2021-22 season.
