**Weather:** Friday: Partly cloudy. High of 75. Wind SSW 5-10 mph. Play was suspended due to darkness at 6:10 p.m. with eight players yet to complete their round. Saturday: The second round resumed at 7:42 a.m. and was completed at 8:12 a.m. Mostly clear. High of 50. Wind calm.

**Thomas Detry (1<sup>st</sup>/-12)**

- Posts 66-64 to set career-low 36-hole total of 130 (previous: 131/2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship/2<sup>nd</sup>)
- One of two PGA TOUR members from Belgium (Adrien Dumont de Chassart)
- Third career 36-hole lead/co-lead on TOUR and first solo 36-hole lead; 0-for-2 converting the victory (T4/2024 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, T9/2022 Sanderson Farms Championship)
- Seeks first PGA TOUR title; owns two career-runner up finishes (2<sup>nd</sup>/2022 Butterfield Bermuda Championship, T2/2024 Texas Children’s Houston Open)
- One top-10 in four previous starts this season (T5/The Sentry); qualified for The Sentry by finishing inside the top 50 in the 2024 FedExCup
- Second career appearance at the WM Phoenix Open (T28/2024)
- Finished No. 42 in the 2024 FedExCup after collecting four top-10 finishes in 2024

**Miscellaneous Notes**

- **Emiliano Grillo** (T62/-2) made a hole-in-one at No. 16, the 12<sup>th</sup> at No. 16 during the WM Phoenix Open and first since Carlos Ortiz (2022/R4); marks Grillo’s second career hole-in-one on TOUR (2019 Open Championship/R1/No. 13)
- **Michael Kim** (T2/-10) is the only player in the field without a bogey after posting a second-round 63 to tie the low round of the tournament (Beau Hossler/R2)
- **Alex Smalley** (T2/-10) posts 65 for his best position through 36 holes on TOUR since the 2022 RBC Canadian Open (T2; finished T21)
- Making his second start on TOUR since undergoing wrist surgery in August, **Jordan Spieth** (T4/-9) cards two eagles in one round (Nos. 13 and 15) for the seventh time on TOUR and second at the WM Phoenix Open (2022/R3/Nos. 3 and 15); owns five top-10s in eight career tournament appearances at the WM Phoenix Open, including back-to-back T6 finishes in 2023 and 2024; playing on the final season his tournament winner exemption (thru 2025) from the 2022 RBC Heritage
- Coming off a T7 at last week’s AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, **Tom Kim** (T4/-9) has not finished inside the top 10 in back-to-back starts on TOUR since the 2023 Genesis Scottish Open (T6) and 2023 Open Championship (T2)
- Amateur **Luke Clanton** (T78/-1) plays his final eight holes in 4-under for a 67 to miss the cut by one stroke; needed to make the cut to earn 1 point in PGA TOUR University Accelerated and reach 20 points to earn PGA TOUR membership following the conclusion of the collegiate season in May.
