








Today – The cold front is north of the area and will slowly move south through the state as we go through the day. Temperatures will not be as hot as previous days, but the tropical airmass remains in place making for muggy conditions. Scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected to redevelop and move across the area during the afternoon/early evening with heavy rainfall.

Extended forecast – Light showers or mist/drizzle will be possible Saturday morning before drier conditions return for the afternoon. Otherwise, mainly cloudy skies and much cooler temperatures can be expected with highs in the mid to upper 70s. A NE breeze of 10-15 mph will make it feel much cooler as well. High pressure will build further into the area on Sunday allowing for partly cloudy skies with highs in the upper 70s. Nice weather will continue into Monday before storm chances Tuesday afternoon.
