








Scattered showers and thunderstorms will become likely between 3pm-5pm and continue into the evening hours. With the tropical airmass in place, thunderstorms could produce very heavy rainfall and flash flooding this afternoon.

Extended forecast – Scattered afternoon showers and thunderstorms will be likely again Friday as a cold front slowly moves south through the state. Storms will be capable of producing heavy rainfall in a short period. Showers may linger into early Saturday before the front settles south of the area. Cooler and drier conditions can be expected Saturday with highs only reaching the upper 70s. Refreshing temperatures will continue Sunday before temperatures begin to slowly moderate early next week.
