Today – A stray passing shower cannot be ruled out this morning under mixed to partly cloudy skies. After 2pm anticipate thunderstorms will develop 30 miles northwest of TPC Louisiana with this activity expected to slow drift southeastward during the late afternoon/early evening prior to dissipating quickly after sunset. Southerly winds of 10-15 mph are expected by late morning with gusts around 18 mph.

Extended forecast – Patchy fog may develop each morning this weekend, with any decrease in visibility expected to improve between 8-9am. A few pop-up showers or an isolated thunderstorm may occur Saturday afternoon, otherwise anticipate dry conditions this weekend under a ridge of high pressure. Southeasterly winds of 7-12 mph are expected each afternoon along with a few gusts to 15 mph. Temperatures will start out in the upper 60s each morning before climbing into the mid 80s.
