Today – A scattered coverage of slow-moving heavy showers and thunderstorms will develop this afternoon before diminishing this evening. South-southeasterly winds will be a bit breezy this afternoon, sustained at 10-15 mph along with occasional higher gusts. The temperature will top out around 82°F.
Forecast rainfall: 0.10" – 0.25", with locally higher totals near 1" in slow-moving thunderstorms.

Extended forecast – The remains a threat for afternoon showers and thunderstorms on Friday, with the highest chances arriving after 3-4pm. More stable conditions arrive this weekend, with just a few showers or an isolated thunderstorm expected each afternoon as a ridge of high pressure limits activity. South-southeasterly winds will become slightly breezy after 10-11am Friday, sustained at 10-15 mph. Temperatures will start out in the upper 60s to low 70s each morning before climbing into the mid 80s.
