Bromont, Québec – Caden Fioroni and Dillon Stewart share the 54-hole lead at the Bromont Open presented by Desjardins at 18-under, after carding rounds of 64 and 66 on Saturday.

After a 2-under 68 in the first round, Fioroni responded with a 6-under 64 to grab a share of the lead heading into Sunday's final round. Fioroni's round was highlighted by an eagle on No. 9, the same hole he recorded an albatross on in the first round. The UNLV alum made his professional debut at the Explore NB Open after finishing as the No. 16 player in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2025.

In his second start on PGA TOUR Americas, Stewart holds a share of the 54-hole lead in a PGA TOUR-sanctioned event for the first time in his professional career. Stewart, an Oklahoma State alum, made his PGA TOUR Americas debut last week in New Brunswick, where he finished T9 at the Explore NB Open.

Following his week in New Brunswick, Stewart carded back-to-back round at 7-under 63 before turning in a 4-under 66 on Saturday. In seven rounds on PGA TOUR Americas, Stewart has carded three 63's, and six sub-70 rounds.

Due to the potential for inclement weather on Sunday afternoon, final round tee times are expected to run from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. local time in threesomes off the Nos. 1 and 10 tees.

About Caden Fioroni (T1/-18)

- Holds a share of the 54-hole lead for the first time as a professional
- Set a new course record at Golf Chateau Bromont with a score of 10-under 60 in the first round of the Bromont Open presented by Desjardins
- Carded the first albatross of his career on No. 9, the 531-yard par-5 in the first round
- Earned status for the 2025 North America Swing after finishing as the No. 16 player in the PGA TOUR University Class of 2025
- Finished his career at UNLV with the second-best career scoring average in Rebels program history (70.80)
- Earned Mountain West Player of the Year honors in 2022
- Won the Southern California Amateur Championship in 2022 by eight strokes at San Diego Country Club
- Won the 2024 California Amateur Championship at Sherwood Country Club: Fioroni became the 13th player to win both the South California and California Amateur Championship
- Recorded a runner-up finish at the 2025 NCAA Urbana Regional
- Fioroni is the son of two Canadians, and became the first person in his family to graduate from an American University

About Dillon Stewart (T1/-18)

- Holds a share of the 54-hole lead for the first time at a PGA TOUR-sanctioned event for the first time in his career
- Finished T8 at PGA TOUR Americas Q-School at Soboba Springs Golf Club in San Jacinto, California, to secure exempt membership for the 2025 North America Swing
- In his final two years at Oklahoma State in from 2021-23, Stewart was named to the Big-12 All-Academic team twice
- Won the Colorado Amateur Championship in 2023, and the Colorado Junior Amateur Championship in 2019
- Won the Colorado Junior PGA Championship in 2019

Competition Notes

Course Setup: Par 70 / 7,000 yards; R3 average: 67.505

Weather: Sunny with a high of 29.5 (87). Wind from the NW at 8-14 km/h with gusts up to 18 km/h.

- Caden Fioroni and Dillon Stewart share the 54-hole lead, after the playing the first three rounds at 18-under 192
- Hole No. 9, the 531-yard par-5, played as the easiest hole in the second round (-0.857 strokes under par): Players carded 13 eagles and 45 birdies on No. 9 on Saturday
- Beau Breault, Carson Bacha, Garrett Reband and Mason Williams carded rounds at 7-under 63, the low round of the day
