Extended forecast –A low (15-25%) threat for rain exists tonight through Saturday, however much of this period likely remains dry. Rain and T-storm chances eventually increase on Sunday as a cold front reaches Wisconsin. Currently, the front and associated precipitation is expected to move through Madison between 11am-4pm. Once confidence improves on timing, this window will likely be refined.
