Today – A cold front will sweep through the area with a broken line of showers and embedded T-storms expected along it. This frontal passage likely takes place between 11am-12pm. Behind the front, widely scattered showers/T-storms could redevelop. If this activity occurs, it could reach the Madison area after 4pm. Southerly winds ahead of the front will become westerly behind it. Gusts around mph will be possible. Forecast rainfall: 0.05-0.15" w/ locally up to 0.25" in T-storm. **Sunrise: 5:17am / Sunset: 8:35pm**

Tomorrow – A dry start to the day, however the threat for showers will increase by the late morning hours and especially during the afternoon. A few embedded lightning strikes are possible in the heaviest showers. Temperatures will be much cooler, only reaching the middle 60s during the afternoon. Winds will start southerly during the morning, eventually becoming west/northwest during the afternoon. Gusts of 20-25 mph are possible. Forecast rainfall: 0.05-0.15" w/ locally up to 0.25" in T-storm. **Sunrise: 5:17am / Sunset: 8:35pm**
