### Things to Know

- Charles Schwab No. 4 **Stewart Cink** matched the low round of the day with bogey-free 64 to take a three-stroke lead over Charles Schwab No. 3 **Steven Alker** and **Paul Goydos** entering the final round of the 20<sup>th</sup> Boeing Classic.

### Stewart Cink, 68-64 – 132 (-12)

- The 52-year-old seeks his third win on PGA TOUR Champions (28<sup>th</sup> start)
  - Previous wins (2): 2024 Ally Challenge, 2025 Insuperity Invitational
- Seeks his second win of the 2025 season (13<sup>th</sup> start)
  - Has nine top-10s in 12 starts this season
  - Entered the week No. 4 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings
- Looks to become the fifth multiple winner of the 2025 season, joining Miguel Angel Jiménez (4), Ángel Cabrera (3), Pádraig Harrington (2) and Steve Allan (2)
- Matched his low 18-hole score of the 2025 season (39<sup>th</sup> round)
  - Cink's previous round of 64 in 2025: Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai (Final Round)
- His three-stroke lead is the largest 36-hole lead of the 2025 season on PGA TOUR Champions
  - Previous largest 36-hole lead of 2025: 2 strokes (Miguel Angel Jiménez, 2025 Principal Charity Classic; Ángel Cabrera, 2025 James Hardie Pro Football Hall of Fame Invitational)
- This is his fifth time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions (1-for-4)
  - Led at the 2024 Cologuard Classic (finished T7)
  - Led at the 2024 Ally Challenge (Won)
  - Co-led at the 2024 Stifel Charity Classic (finished 3<sup>rd</sup>)
  - Co-led at the 2025 U.S. Senior Open (finished 2<sup>nd</sup>) – 72-hole event
- Will play in the last group of the final round for the third time this season (0-for-2)
  - Cologuard Classic (finished T8)
  - U.S. Senior Open (finished 2<sup>nd</sup>)
- Is making his tournament debut at the Boeing Classic

**Other Notes**

- Charles Schwab No. 3 **Steven Alker** posted 68 and sits T2 at 9-under. Making his fifth appearance at the Boeing Classic, Alker has finished (chronologically) T7 (2021), 5<sup>th</sup> (2022), T3 (2023) and T2 (2024).
  - Note: the 2021 Boeing Classic was Alker's PGA TOUR Champions debut after Monday qualifying into the field.
- 61-year-old **Paul Goydos** (T2) posted 69 and enters the final round at 9-under. Goydos seeks his sixth win on PGA TOUR Champions (248<sup>th</sup> start).
  - Last win: 2017 3M Championship
- First-round co-leaders **Jerry Kelly** and **Matt Gogel** each carded 1-under 71 and sit T4 at 8-under along with **Steve Allan**. Allan seeks his third win of the 2025 season after capturing The Galleri Classic (March 28-30) and DICK'S Open (July 11-13).
- World Golf Hall of Fame member **Ernie Els** is one of four players sitting T7 at 7-under.
- 2022 champion and Charles Schwab Cup leader **Miguel Angel Jiménez** is T11 at 6-under.
- Two-time defending champion **Stephen Ames** is T19 at 5-under.
- **Y.E. Yang** matched Cink for the low round of the day (64) to move from T69 to T19 on the leaderboard.
