Things to Know

• Starting the day four strokes back, **Steve Allan** closed with the low round of the day (65) to win the 20th Boeing Classic for his third victory of the 2025 season.

Steve Allan, 68-68-65 - 201 (-15)

- The 51-year-old earned his third win on PGA TOUR Champions (39 starts)
 - o 2025 Galleri Classic
 - o 2025 DICK'S Open
 - o 2025 Boeing Classic
- Becomes the third three-time winner of the 2025 season on PGA TOUR Champions, joining Miguel Angel Jiménez (4) and Ángel Cabrera (3)
- Moves up one spot in the Charles Schwab Cup standings to No. 7
- Matched the largest final-round comeback of the 2025 season (4 strokes)
 - Previous instance: Steven Alker (Cologuard Classic)
- Matched his second-lowest 18-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions (116 rounds)
 - o This was his fifth time shooting 65 on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Allan's low round on PGA TOUR Champions: 63 (2025 DICK'S Open, 1st Round)
- In one previous appearance at the Boeing Classic, he finished T44 (2024)
- This is the 39th win by a player from Australia on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Wins by Australians: Bruce Crampton (20), Graham Marsh (6), David Graham (5), Steve Allan (3), Rod Pampling (2), Rodger Davis (1), Bruce Devlin (1), Mark Hensby (1)

Other Notes

- 36-hole leader Stewart Cink closed with 70 to finish runner-up at 14-under.
 - In his last three starts, he has finished 3rd (Kaulig Companies Championship), 2nd (U.S. Senior Open) and 2nd (Boeing Classic).
 - o Cink moves up to No. 2 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings after starting the week No. 4.
- Darren Clarke and World Golf Hall of Fame member Ernie Els each closed with 66 to finish T3 at 13-under.
 - This is Els' ninth top-10 finish of the season (17 starts).

- This is Clarke's fourth top-10 finish this season (15 starts).
- Two-time defending champion **Stephen Ames** and 2022 champion **Miguel Angel Jiménez** each finished T14 at 7-under.
 - Jiménez remains atop the Charles Schwab Cup standings for the 15th week (of a possible 18 weeks) this season.
- Greg Chalmers was disqualified during the final round for using a non-conforming club (Rule 4.1a).
- Fred Funk withdrew during the final round.
