Things to Know

- Seeking his first win on PGA TOUR Champions, **Justin Leonard** holds a one-stroke lead over World Golf Hall of Fame member **Ernie Els** entering the final round of the Chubb Classic presented by SERVPRO.

Justin Leonard, 68-65 – 133 (-11)

- Matched the low round of the day with 7-under 65
- The 52-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (45th start)
 - Best finish: 2nd (2023 PURE Insurance Championship)
- This is his second time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions (0-for-1)
- Making his third start of the 2025 season, his best finish is T8 (Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai)
- Will play in the last group of the final round for the first time since the 2023 season
- Making his third appearance at the Chubb Classic, he has finished T6 (2023) and T61 (2024)

Ernie Els, 67-67 – 134 (-10)

- The 55-year-old seeks his eighth win on PGA TOUR Champions (107th start)
 - Last win: 2025 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai
- Seeks his second win of the 2025 season (third start)
 - Would be his third multi-win season on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Previous instances: 2 wins (2020-21); 3 wins (2024)
- With a win on Sunday, he would become the first player since 2022 to win two of the first three tournaments of the season on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Most recent: Miguel Angel Jiménez (2022 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai; 2022 Cologuard Classic)
- The World Golf Hall of Fame member will play in the last group of the final round for the second time this season (1-for-1)
- Making his fifth appearance at the Chubb Classic, he has three top-10 finishes at this event
 - Best finish at the Chubb Classic: T3 (2024)

Other Notes

- First-round co-leader **Paul Stankowski** posted 1-under 71 and sits in 3rd at 8-under. The 55-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (80th start).
- Making his debut on PGA TOUR Champions, 50-year-old **Felipe Aguilar** matched the low round of the day with bogey-free 65 and sits T4 at 7-under. Aguilar earned his 2025 PGA TOUR Champions card by finishing 4th at Q-School (Final Stage) in December 2024.
- In addition to Aguilar, five other players are T4 at 7-under: 2018 Chubb Classic champion **Joe Durant**, rookie **Freddie Jacobson**, first alternate **Heath Slocum**, two-time Chubb Classic runner-up (2018, 2022) **Tim Petrovic** and three-time PGA TOUR Champions winner **Billy Andrade**.
- First-round co-leader **Mario Tiziani** carded 73 and sits T10 at 6-under.
- Five-time champion (2011, 2013, 2016, 2022, 2023) **Bernhard Langer** (T18) shot bogey-free 68 and enters the final round at 4-under.
- **Billy Mayfair** withdrew before the start of the second round.
