Things to Know

- Starting the day with a one-stroke lead, **Justin Leonard** closed with 68, birdying five of his final seven holes, en route to his first win on PGA TOUR Champions at the Chubb Classic presented by SERVPRO.

Justin Leonard, 68-65-68 – 201 (-15)

- The 52-year-old earned his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (45 starts)
 - Previous best finish: 2nd (2023 PURE Insurance Championship)
- Snaps a winless streak of 6,097 days (or 16 years, 8 months, 8 days), dating back to the 2008 Stanford St. Jude Championship
- Becomes the first first-time winner on PGA TOUR Champions since Tim O'Neal (2024 Dominion Energy Charity Classic)
- This is his low 54-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions (201)
 - Previous best: 202 (2023 PURE Insurance Championship)
- This is the largest margin of victory of the 2025 season on PGA TOUR Champions (4 strokes)
 - Last margin of victory larger than four strokes on PGA TOUR Champions: 2023 TimberTech Championship (7 strokes, Padraig Harrington)
 - Note: three tournaments in 2024 had a winning margin of four strokes
- In two previous starts this season on PGA TOUR Champions, his best finish was T8 (Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai)
- In two previous appearances at the Chubb Classic, he finished T6 (2023) and T61 (2024)
- Improved to 1-for-2 when leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Led at the 2023 PURE Insurance Championship (finished 2nd)

Other Notes

- Seeking his first win since 2015, **Billy Andrade** finished runner-up at 11-under after posting 68. This is his best finish on PGA TOUR Champions since the 2019 PURE Insurance Championship (2nd).
- **Darren Clarke** finished 3rd at 10-under for his 10th top-3 finish on PGA TOUR Champions (130 starts).
- Two-time champion (2010, 2017) **Fred Couples** carded the low round of the day (66) to finish T4 at 9-under.
- Starting the round one stroke behind 36-hole leader Leonard, **Ernie Els** finished 11th after closing with a birdie-less 75. Els moves up to No. 1 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings.
- Five-time champion (2011, 2013, 2016, 2022, 2023) **Bernhard Langer** finished T12 at 6-under.

- Making his debut on PGA TOUR Champions, 50-year-old **Felipe Aguilar** finished T12.
