#### Things to Know

• 51-year-old **Greg Chalmers** opened with eight birdies, one-bogey 64 and holds a two-stroke lead over **Rod Pampling**, **Stephen Ames** and World Golf Hall of Fame member **Ernie Els.** 

#### Greg Chalmers, 32-32 - 64 (-7)

- This is his low 18-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions (71st round)
  - Previous low 18-hole score: 66 (Twice: Last, 2024 Charles Schwab Cup Championship, Final Round)
- This is second time leading/co-leading after any round on PGA TOUR Champions
  - Previous best position: T1 (2024 Senior PGA Championship, Third Round)
- The 51-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (23rd start)
  - Best finish: 3rd (Twice: Last, 2024 Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS)
  - Lone victory in 485 PGA TOUR starts came at the 2016 Barracuda Championship
- Making his third start of the 2025 season, he finished T14 at the Trophy Hassan II
- One year after making his PGA TOUR Champions debut through Monday qualifying, he is making his second appearance at the Cologuard Classic by Exact Sciences (T7/2024)

#### **Other Notes**

- Rod Pampling sits T2 after carding a bogey-free 5-under 66. The 55-year-old seeks his third win on PGA TOUR Champions (119th start).
  - Last win: 2023 SAS Championship
  - Making his sixth appearance in the Cologuard Classic by Exact Sciences
    - Best finish: T3/2021
- **Stephen Ames** sits T2 after opening with bogey-free 66. The 60-year-old seeks his 10<sup>th</sup> win on PGA TOUR Champions (224<sup>th</sup> start).
  - Last win: 2024 Boeing Classic
  - Making his 11<sup>th</sup> start in the Cologuard Classic by Exact Sciences
    - Best finish: T4/2016
- Despite bogeying three holes, World Golf Hall of Fame member Ernie Els carded 5-under 66 and sits T2. The 55-year-old seeks his eighth win on PGA TOUR Champions and second this season (108th start).
