**Extended Forecast** – A slight chance for tshowers will linger through the overnight hours into tomorrow morning. A chance for tstorms will develop once again with peak heating of the day during the afternoon into the evening. Tstorms are likely as early as mid-afternoon on Sunday with lingering activity expected heading into early next week. Overnight lows will be in the 60s with daytime highs in the 80s. Winds are expected to remain relatively light through the period. Valley fog will be possible each morning during the extended forecast as sufficient moisture remains in place across the region.
