Eight players sit T1 at 4-under

- Brett Quigley
 - Making his fifth start in the event, birdied Nos. 11,12,13 and 15 before bogeying No. 16 with two holes to play in the first round. Best finish (T13/2021)
- Billy Andrade
 - Seeking his first win in his 11th appearance at the Insperity Invitational, sits bogey-free with three holes to play. Best finish (T5/2016)
- Ken Tanigawa
 - Making his sixth appearance in the event, has three holes remaining (Nos. 7-9) Best finish (T7/2019)
- Thongchai Jaidee
 - Is bogey-free through 12 holes in his third start at the Insperity Invitational. Best finish (T4/2024)
- Mike Weir
 - The 2021 Insperity Invitational champion began his round with an eagle on No. 1 and posted back-toback birdies on Nos. 6 and 7; has six holes to play in his fifth appearance in the event.
- Y.E. Yang
 - Making his fourth start in the event, he began his round on the back nine where he birdied five of seven, Nos. 13,14,15,17 and 1 and shares the lead with six holes to play in the first round. Best finish (T10/2024)
- Chad Campbell
 - Making his debut in the Insperity Invitational, opened his first round with birdies on Nos. 11,13,16 and an eagle on No. 15 before bogeying No. 18 to make the turn as play was suspended. Seeking his first
