Round 1 Interview Transcript
-4 (Thru 16)
May 2, 2025

Question: Well, just talk about your round. You played pretty well. You got 16 holes in, -4?

Brett Quigley Answer:

Yeah. I mean, obviously good so far. But the cool part, I was with Fred Funk today. So, I mean, I was just — I was watching that and just really neat to be with him during his 1,000th tournament. And I was at University of South Carolina when he was coach, golf coach at Maryland. So I've known Freddie for a long time and got some history there too. So, again, very cool to be with him for that. Golf is just secondary to that.

Question: They gave him a cake, then, right?

Brett Quigley Answer:

Yeah. I'm trying to go get some, if there's any even left.

Question: And then your round?

Brett Quigley Answer:

Yeah, I played a nice round — just pretty steady. I mean, it wasn't anything unusual, pretty steady. Nothing on the mental — I mean, the scores — the golf course is soft, so — and the greens are perfect; so the scores will be — I mean, these guys are pretty good players out here.

Question: Talk about the weather. I mean, how disappointing is it, because you only had, what, two holes left?

Brett Quigley Answer:

Yeah, one and a half. I'm on the fairway on 17. So, yeah, it's a bummer; but everybody's gotta deal with it tomorrow because nobody finished. So I imagine we'll just keep going around tomorrow and hopefully no more weather for the rest of the week.

Question: You were out here last year?

Brett Quigley Answer:

Yeah. I don't remember all the history here, but it feels like it rains here a lot during the event. And so we're used to this.

Question: I was going to say, because I cover golf all the time. And Houston Open it rains. LPGA Chevron last week rained. So — and you guys get rain on the Tour all the time. But does it — does it really seem like, though, that Houston may get more than its share?

Brett Quigley Answer:

It sure does, at least the last few years here. Yeah. But even the Tour days I remember being in rain delays here too. So not — not unusual. We expect it; so it's not a big deal.

Question: Okay. One final question from me. So, you know, mentally now, what do you do the rest of the day?

Brett Quigley Answer:

I'm going to go work out, do laundry, and it's going to be a really exciting afternoon. (laughing) Hopefully the hotel laundry room isn't too full.
