Round 3 Interview Transcript

Question: I guess let's talk about shooting your age again for, what is it, 29th time?

Bernard Langer Answer:

It's always fun. You know, it's a little game I have with myself because in the end I play against myself and against the golf course. I have no control what the other players do. You know, whether they shoot 60 or 80, it's out of my control. So I just — yeah. I enjoy when I shoot my age or break, even better. So I guess it means I'm playing well.

Question: You know, Tom Lehman did it for the first time today?

Bernard Langer Answer:

Okay. Cool. Yeah.

Question: And I talked to him, he kind of mentioned that you had done it when you were 64?

Bernard Langer Answer:

Yes. Shot 64 on my 64th birthday, so... yep.

Question: Well, I mean, a good tournament for you. Just talk about how well you played today?

Bernard Langer Answer:

I played good all week, pretty much. I just couldn't make all the putts I wanted to make the first couple days. And same again today. I had numerous chances. I made a real long one out of nowhere; and then I miss, you know, three or four from 10, 12 feet. So it's, yeah, one of those things. If you want to win, you can't afford doing that.

Question: You're a four-time champion here. What is it about coming back here and, like, just the support you have from fans, how well the tournament's run here? Just overall thoughts on the week.

Bernard Langer Answer:

Everything they do here is top-notch. It's first class, you know, from just everything. Naugle and his team, they do a great job, and the Insperity, Paul Savardi's got a team surrounding him, they don't do anything that's not great. And you can see it in the details. You can see it in the food and the facilities and the way that everything is presented. So it's fun coming back here. Brings wonderful memories. This was my first win on the Champions Tour a long time ago now. So — and I have won it four times. So it's been a good course for me and a great tournament.
