Today – Mostly cloudy and windy conditions can be expected this morning before another round of showers and thunderstorms moves through the area during the early afternoon as upper-level energy rotates through the region. Storms could produce brief heavy rainfall and gusty winds as they pass. Otherwise, the showers will likely taper-off between 4pm-5pm with drier and cooler conditions expected through the rest of the day.

Extended forecast — High pressure will begin to build into the region Friday providing warmer temperatures with highs in the low 80s. Upper-level energy will pass to the north and could produce an isolated shower or thunderstorm as it passes during the late afternoon. Otherwise, high pressure will dominate the weather pattern through the weekend providing hot temperatures into early next week. High will reach the upper 80s Saturday and low 90s on Sunday. This will push the heat indices into the upper 90s Sunday afternoon and around 100F Monday.
