Q. It wasn't easy out there today, was it?

ROBERT KARLSSON: No, it was really tricky. The greens are super, super firm, quick. It becomes kind of a defensive type of play. You end up hitting a lot of long putts because even if you hit decent shots, the greens are slopey and some just roll away, so it was a grind.

Q. Happy to live in North Carolina now for a little while. Does that help at all?

ROBERT KARLSSON: No, not at all because this, this is bermudagrass and my home course we have bentgrass greens so we don't play this at all, but maybe playing last week in Jacksonville. But this is quite unique, it's not very often we play greens that are this firm. I don't know what the word is English, they just don't bite, they just run out. Seems to be a lot of sand in them. I know they had a really, really bad summer because I live in Charlotte, a lot of rain and then after that serious drought. The greens, I think they saved them with a lot of sand. They putt very well but they're kind of tricky. You don't get any break on them.

Q. (Inaudible) where you stand in the Schwab Cup. This is a nice move.

ROBERT KARLSSON: Yeah. It's day one but I'm looking more on the long term. I'm pretty happy with the way I played since mid August I would say. I'm pretty happy where things are going. Obviously last week I played nicely. Changed nothing on the money list really. You can't get too caught up in that, the whole thing is to try to play as good as I can ever shot, every hole, every round, so it is what it is.

Q. Good golf takes care of everything, doesn't it?
