BRANDT JOBE: Can I cuss?

Hundred percent, yeah. That would be stupid to say, that's another opportunity, that's all we want is opportunities.

But like I told you, I mean, I wasted three quarters of the season trying to figure out how to get my body to work again, then come here and play poorly. So that doesn't leave a good taste for the year, but that's kind of it in a nutshell.

Q. What's the next step for you?



BRANDT JOBE: You know what, take some time off and reflect a little bit, see what next year, see what tournaments I get in. Obviously I still have the desire to do it, so we'll see. I don't know where that's going to land me or how many opportunities. Obviously you're going to try and get some sponsor's invites and things like that, but we'll see. This is my 10th year, so I'm pretty lucky. Tenth year without really having a clear path and I've had a clear path, so I can't be disappointed.

I remember coming out here saying if you give me five years, that would be great, and I got 10. If next year's 10 tournaments, 12 tournaments, whatever it is, embrace it and hopefully build on the last couple few months of what I did.

And then I'm not afraid to get to work. I still enjoy it, but I don't enjoy playing how I did this year. This was very, very hard mentally. Playing poorly every week there for a while, you really want to just say, OK, I can't do it. But I saw some glimmers of hope, even today played well minus one swing, shoot 3 under. So you've got to take some positive out of everything.
