FELIPE AGUILAR (+2)



Q. Nice playing today. Did your standing in the Schwab Cup dictate the way you played today?

FELIPE AGUILAR: Well, been struggling throughout this year. Having some bad breaks throughout the round obviously puts a little pressure. I like to play under pressure. Maybe I have to concentrate a little bit more.

But I think that's a consequence of the way I play. What I mean by that is I can't do anything about what the other guys do, I just have to try to do my best out here today. It was a little bit colder today, it was a little bit windier. I mean, conditions aren't great. The conditions are great but it's difficult. Therefore, you have to be patient out here. The greens are very slippery, very fast. As long as you don't make too many mistakes, which is one of the things I concentrate today, we're going to be fine.

Q. The weather that's coming tomorrow, did that dictate maybe the way you played?

FELIPE AGUILAR: It might, it might depending how I finish today. Sometimes we have a little couple strokes ahead. I mean, sometimes you don't take certain risks, you know, or if you make a mistake it doesn't really matter because you have something in the bank like I say. It might, it might really dictate what happens today because obviously I need to make sure I'm in the top 72 for next week. It's not that I'm going to win this event this year -- yeah, actually this year because I'm not even close. I need to see what the other guys are doing.

Q. Right now you're 69th. I'm not sure if you know this but Mr. Weir withdrew so he's getting no money for this week. That's a good thing for you.

FELIPE AGUILAR: Yeah. Well, sad news that he withdrew because I played with him yesterday, he played good. I didn't know he was injured or something. Well, that's too bad. As I said before, I can't do anything about it, I'm just going to try to play good enough so next week, whenever I play next week I play good enough to make it to the next week's playoff, which I think is 44?
