Today – Dry conditions likely prevail much of the morning with the threat for rain increasing between 11am-1pm. Rainfall intensity may become heavy during the afternoon, especially after 2pm. Additionally, a threat for lightning will also develop. Temperatures should only warm into the 60s today with an east to southeast wind in place. Some gusts over 15 mph are possible.

Extended forecast – Additional waves of rain are likely tonight with embedded lightning possible. Heavy rain is also a concern with this activity. Rain coverage and intensity will diminish by sunrise Sunday, however the potential for showers could persist much of the day. An isolated T-storm also can't be ruled out. Easterly winds can be expected on Sunday with a high temperature near 70F.
