**Extended Forecast** — A cold front will push into central Florida during the day Saturday and then briefly retreat northward on Sunday. Given the proximity of the front tomorrow, areas of showers and perhaps an embedded T-storm should develop across the Tampa area. Rain chances likely diminish Saturday night into Sunday as the front lifts back to the north. Eventually, the threat for showers redevelop late in the day Sunday and more so Sunday night. Winds may briefly turn to the northwest Saturday afternoon, otherwise a predominantly south or southwest direction is expected the weekend. Gusts could exceed 20 mph a times.
