**Extended Forecast** — Dry and warm conditions are expected on Friday with a decent southerly breeze developing. A slow-moving front will be draped across northern Florida much of the weekend, keeping the mor significant and steadier rains north of Tampa for much of period. With that said, low (30-40%) chances for showers and isolated T-storms will exist Saturday into Sunday morning. Shower coverage could begin to increase Sunday afternoon and more so Sunday night. Southwesterly winds are expected Saturday/Sunday with gusts possibly exceeding 20 mph each day.
