Things to Know

- Marks sixth playoff on PGA TOUR Champions this season; marks second consecutive playoff at this event and third playoff in tournament history
- Thomas Bjørn earns first individual title on PGA TOUR Champions
- Last year, Bjørn was a sponsor exemption (finished T60) before winning this year

Thomas Bjørn, 65-69-67 – 201 (-12)

- The 54-year-old earned his second win on PGA TOUR Champions and second victory this season (40 starts)
 - o 2025 Stifel Charity Classic
 - o 2025 American Family Insurance Championship
- Becomes the sixth multiple winner of the 2025 season, joining Miguel Angel Jiménez (4), Ángel Cabrera (3), Steve Allan (3), Padraig Harrington (2) and Stewart Cink (2)
- Moves to No. 6 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings, entered the week at No. 8
- Started the round one shot back from the lead; marks first victory for Bjørn coming from behind
- 1-for-1 in converting during a playoff on PGA TOUR Champions
- Earns best finish at the Stifel Charity Classic in his second start (T60/2024)

Additional Notes

 Cameron Percy (P2/-12) was seeking to become the third Australian in the last four starts to win on PGA TOUR Champions this season (Steve Allan/Boeing Classic; Richard Green/Rogers Charity Classic)

- Percy played the front 9 at 10-under this week; shot the low-round of the day (64) and matched the low-round of the week (64/R1/Stewart Cink)
- Moves to 0-for-2 in playoffs on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Lost to Thomas Bjørn at the 2025 Stifel Charity Classic
 - Lost to Miguel Angel Jimenez at the 2025 Principal Charity Classic
- Alex Cejka (3rd/-11) secures best finish in fourth start at the Stifel Charity Classic (T45/2024, T40/2023, T23/2020)
- Last man in the field **Heath Slocum** (T4/-10) finishes in the top-10 for the second time this season (T4/Chubb Classic) and qualifies for next week's Sanford International
- Paul Stankowski (T4/-10) was looking to become the 23rd player to win on PGA TOUR Champions, PGA TOUR and Korn Ferry Tour; Cink is the most recent player to achieve that feat (2024/The Ally Challenge)
- 36-hole co-leader **Stewart Cink** (8th/-8) retains his position in the Charles Schwab Cup Rankings (No. 2); marks his 12th top-10 finish this season in 15 starts
- **Jerry Kelly** (T17/-4) made an albatross on No. 2; marks the third albatross on PGA TOUR Champions this season (Stephen Ames/Mitsubishi Electric Classic; Kris Blanks/Chubb Classic)
