Defending champion **Stewart Cink** enters the week No. 2 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings. He is one of four past champions in the 2025 field, including World Golf Hall of Fame member **Vijay Singh**. Singh of one of five Hall of Famers teeing it up at Warwick Hills, along with Charles Schwab No. 4 **Padraig Harrington**, No. 6 **Ernie Els**, **Retief Goosen** and 47-time PGA TOUR Champions winner **Bernhard Langer**.
