Extended forecast – A fast moving cold front will sweep across Michigan on Saturday, most likely reaching Warwick Hills between 2-5pm. Overall, any shower/T-storm development is likely confined along the front and could remain sparse in coverage. Cooler conditions return behind the front on Sunday. An isolated shower could also occur but much of the day will remain dry. Wind gusts over 20 mph will be possible Saturday and Sunday
