Things to Know

- Australia's **Steve Allan** holds a one-shot lead heading into the final round of The Galleri Classic Presented by Spotlight 29 Casino.
- After earning a spot in this week's field via Tuesday's open qualifier, **Tag Ridings** tied the tournament's low 18-hole scoring record of 63, previously set by Ricardo Gonzalez in the 2024 Galleri Classic.

Steve Allan

- Claims the 36-hole lead/co-lead for the 1st time on PGA TOUR Champions (28 starts)
- Making his second start in The Galleri Classic (T26/2024); earned his spot in this week's field via GRAIL ambassador Steve Stricker's withdrawal
- Matched his low 18-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Previous: 2024 Rogers Charity Classic/Round 2
- Will play in the final group in the final round for the second time on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Is 0-1 when converting them into victories
- The 51-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Best finish: T5/2024 Ally Challenge
 - Finished T3 in the Final Stage of the 2023 PGA TOUR Champions Qualifying Tournament

Tag Ridings

- The 50-year-old seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (2nd start)
 - Will play in the final group in the final round for the first time on PGA TOUR Champions
- Making his first start at The Galleri Classic after Tuesday qualifying at Bermuda Dunes Country Club and posting 8-under 64, the low round of the day
- Made his PGA TOUR Champions debut at the 2025 Cologuard Classic by Exact Sciences (T30), where he Monday qualified to get into the field
- Finished T19 at Final Stage of PGA TOUR Champions Q School for 2025 season
- Made 239 career starts on the PGA TOUR, with his best finish coming at the 2004 Michelin Championship at Las Vegas (T2)
- In his Korn Ferry Tour career, has competed in 296 events, with two wins: 2002 Permian Basin Open and 2021 TPC Colorado Championship

Other Notes

- Three players sit T3 at 8-under
 - Reigning Charles Schwab Cup champion **Steven Alker** posted a bogey-free 7-under and seeks his 10th win on PGA TOUR Champions (80 starts)
 - Looks to become the second multi-winner this season along with Miguel Angel Jimenez
 - His first win of the 2025 season was at the 2025 Cologuard Classic by Exact Sciences
 - Seeks his first win at The Galleri Classic after posting runner-up finishes in 2023 and 2024.
 - 18-hole co-leader **Cameron Percy** carded 3-under and is seeking his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (21 starts)
 - Best finish: 3rd/2024 American Family Insurance Championship
 - **Jason Caron** closed his round with a birdie to post 4-under in his first appearance at The Galleri Classic; seeks his first win on PGA TOUR Champions (Best finish: P2/Cologuard Classic by Exact Sciences)
- Defending champion **Retief Goosen** sits T16 at 4-under
- 2023 champion **David Toms** sits T29 at 2-under
- **Rocco Mediate** and **Mark Calcavecchia** withdrew in the second round due to injury.
