Things to Know

•

- **Mark Hensby** and World Golf Hall of Fame member and 2022 champion **Pádraig Harrington** share the firstround lead after opening with 67s at The Broadmoor (East Course) in Colorado Springs, Colorado.
- No player in the 156-man field posted a bogey-free round; Harrington remained bogey-free through 14 holes.
- The starting field of 156 golfers will be cut after 36 holes to the low 60 scorers and ties.

Mark Hensby, 30-37 - 67 (-3)

- Matched his Round 1 low 18-hole score at the U.S. Senior Open Championship
 - Previous instance: 2022 U.S. Senior Open Championship
- This is his fourth time leading/co-leading after the first round on PGA TOUR Champions
 Is 1-for-3 converting those into victories, 0-1 in 72-hole events
- The 53-year-old seeks his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (68th start)
 - Last win: 2023 Invited Celebrity Classic
- Making his 14th start of the 2025 season, he has one top-10 finish and entered the week No. 30 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings
- Making his fourth appearance at the U.S. Senior Open, he has finished 3rd (2022), T47 (2023) and T31 (2024)

Pádraig Harrington, 32-35-67 (-3)

- This is his seventh time leading/co-leading after the first round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Is 3-for-6 converting those into victories; 0-for-2 converting those into victories in 72-hole events
- The 53-year-old seeks his 10th win on PGA TOUR Champions (58th start) and second U.S. Senior Open Championship title
 - Last win: 2024 Simmons Bank Championship
 - Last U.S. Senior Open Championship win: 2022
- Making his 9th start of the 2025 season, he has three top-10 finishes and entered the week No. 17 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings
- Making his fourth appearance at the U.S. Senior Open, he has finished 1st (2022), T18 (2023) and T16 (2024)

Other Notes

• Seven players are T3 at 2-under, including six PGA TOUR Champions players, **Bob Estes**, **Freddie Jacobson**, **Ken Tanigawa**, **Thomas Bjørn**, **Stewart Cink**, **Matt Gogel** and one Legends Tour player, **Stephen Gallacher**.

- Cink is making his first U.S. Senior Open appearance; best finish in 23 U.S. Open appearances: 3rd/2001
- Charles Schwab Cup leader **Miguel Angel Jimenez** sits T10 after shooting 1-under 69. The 61-year-old seeks his fifth win of the 2025 season on PGA TOUR Champions (14th start) and second-consecutive senior major.
 - Previous 2025 wins: Trophy Hassan II, Hoag Classic, Principal Charity Classic, Kaulig Companies Championship
- **David Toms**, who captured the U.S. Senior Open when it was last played at The Broadmoor in 2018, opened with 1over par and sits T33.
