#### Things to Know

- First-round co-leaders **Pádraig Harrington** and **Mark Hensby** share the second-round lead with **Stewart Cink** heading into the weekend at the 45th U.S. Senior Open Championship.
- Through 36 holes, no player in the 154-man field carded a bogey-free round.
- **36-hole cut**: 64 players posted 5-over or better to make the cut from a field of 154 players.
- Weather Delay: Play was suspended for 67 minutes due to lightning from 1:00 p.m. to 2:07 p.m. MDT.

### Pádraig Harrington, 67-67 – 134 (-6)

- This is his ninth time leading/co-leading after the second round on PGA TOUR Champions
  - o Is 6-for-8 converting those into victories; 1-for-2 converting those into victories in 72-hole events
    - Won/2022 U.S. Senior Open Championship
    - T2/2023 Senior PGA Championship
- The 53-year-old seeks his 10<sup>th</sup> win on PGA TOUR Champions (58<sup>th</sup> start) and second U.S. Senior Open Championship title
  - o Last win: 2024 Simmons Bank Championship
  - o Last U.S. Senior Open Championship win: 2022
- Making his ninth start of the 2025 season; has three top-10 finishes and entered the week No. 17 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings
- Making his fourth appearance at the U.S. Senior Open,; has finished 1st (2022), T18 (2023) and T16 (2024)

### Stewart Cink, 68-66 - 134 (-6)

- Carded the low round of the day after finishing with birdies on five of his final seven holes (Nos. 3,4,6,8 & 9)
- Hit all 18 greens in regulation, marking 35 of 36 GIR thus far
- This is his fifth time leading/co-leading after the second round on PGA TOUR Champions
  - o Is 1-for-4 converting those into victories; 0-for-1 converting those into victories in 72-hole events
  - The 52-year-old seeks his third win on PGA TOUR Champions (27<sup>th</sup> start) and second this season o Last win: 2025 Insperity Invitational
- Making his 12th start of the 2025 season, he has eight top-10 finishes and entered the week No. 4 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings

#### Mark Hensby, 67-67 – 134 (-6)

- This is his first time leading/co-leading after the second round on PGA TOUR Champions
- The 53-year-old seeks his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (68<sup>th</sup> start)

   Last win: 2023 Invited Celebrity Classic
- Making his 14th start of the 2025 season, he has one top-10 finish and entered the week No. 30 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings
- Making his fourth appearance at the U.S. Senior Open, he has finished 3rd (2022), T47 (2023) and T31 (2024)

#### **Other Notes**

- **Thomas Bjørn** will play the weekend in his second U.S. Senior Open start after shooting 3-under 67; previous finish: T38/2024
- Making his 10<sup>th</sup> appearance in the U.S. Senior Open, **Billy Andrade** sits T5 at 2-under along with **Y.E. Yang**.
- Darren Clarke sits T7 in his sixth U.S. Senior Open event; now 4-6 making the cut
- Steve Flesch will play the weekend in his eighth appearance at the U.S. Senior Open and sits T7; now 4-8 making the cut
- Charles Schwab Cup leader **Miguel Angel Jimenez** sits T7 after shooting 1-under 69 for the second-consecutive day. The 61-year-old seeks his fifth win of the 2025 season on PGA TOUR Champions (14th start) and second-consecutive senior major.
  - Previous 2025 wins: Trophy Hassan II, Hoag Classic, Principal Charity Classic, Kaulig Companies Championship
- Five players are T10, including Paul Stankowski, Freddie Jacobson, Arjun Atwal, Scott Hend and Adilson da Silva.
- **David Toms**, who captured the U.S. Senior Open when it was last played at The Broadmoor in 2018, birdied No. 18 to post 5-over and make the cut.
- Notables to miss the cut: Angel Cabrera, who captured the first two senior majors this season; 2010 and 2022 champion and World Golf Hall of Fame member **Bernhard Langer** will not play the weekend.
- Scott Verplank and Stuart Smith withdrew during the second round.
