

Korn Ferry Tour Tournament History

AdventHealth Championship

2026 marks the 16th playing of the event

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

- The 2026 AdventHealth Championship is the tournament's first year as the regular season finale, with Golf Channel providing television coverage for the first time.
- Blue Hills Country Club finished among the top 10 toughest courses on Tour (measured by scoring average relative to par) three times in its six seasons as the host venue: 2019 (No. 3), 2022 (No. 4), 2025 (No. 6).
- Four past champions of the event became PGA TOUR winners: Wesley Bryan (2016), Sepp Straka (2018), Cameron Young (2021), and Grayson Murray (2023).
- Cameron Young, who won the 2021 AdventHealth Championship and followed it a week later with a win at the 2021 Evans Scholars Invitational, captured the 2025 PLAYERS Championship for his second PGA TOUR title.
- The AdventHealth Championship received the 2025 Charity of the Year Award as part of the annual Korn Ferry Tour Tournament Awards, recognizing its charitable impact on the AdventHealth Kansas City Foundation. The tournament also established the Grayson Murray Be Kind to One Another Legacy Award in 2025, honoring the legacy of 2023 champion Grayson Murray, who passed away in May 2024.

- S.H. Kim converted a five-stroke 54-hole lead into a three-stroke victory for his first Korn Ferry Tour title, totaling 20-under 268 for the lowest 72-hole score at the AdventHealth Championship since the tournament relocated to Blue Hills Country Club in 2019.
- Kim, a four-time runner-up prior to the win, went on to finish No. 8 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, earning PGA TOUR membership via the Korn Ferry Tour for the second time in four years (previously graduated in 2022).
- Alvaro Ortiz went on to finish No. 26 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, retaining full status for the 2026 season. Ortiz earned his first Korn Ferry Tour title at the 2026 UNC Health Championship, defeating Ross Steelman in a playoff.
- Five of the 13 players who finished T10 or higher eventually finished in the top 20 of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List, earning PGA TOUR membership for the 2026 season: S.H. Kim (Won), Sudarshan Yellamaraju (6th), Pontus Nyholm (T8), Adrien Dumont de Chassart (T10), Austin Smotherman (T10).
