- Emilio Gonzalez earned his first Korn Ferry Tour title in what was his 58th career start on Tour. Gonzalez went on to finish No. 5 on the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List and earn PGA TOUR membership for 2026 season.
- Gonzalez closed in 10-under 61, becoming the fourth player in Korn Ferry Tour history to card a score of 61 or lower in the final round and win a 72-hole tournament.

- Jeffrey Kang and Adrien Dumont de Chassart both went on to finish in the top 20 of the 2025 Korn Ferry Tour Points List as well, with both earning PGA TOUR membership for 2026.
